

Frequently Asked Questions

Q WHEN WILL THE WINNERS BE ANNOUNCED?

Winners will be announced and presented with their awards at the ceremony on Sunday 29 May, 2011 at Wales Millennium Centre, Cardiff Bay. Winners will also be listed on the BAFTA in Wales website.

Q WHEN WILL MY BOOKING FOR TICKETS BE CONFIRMED?

Deadline for return of ticket booking forms is Monday 9 May 2011. BAFTA in Wales will contact you by Monday 16 May, 2011 to confirm your booking.

Q WHEN WILL I RECEIVE MY TICKET(S)?

For security reasons, all tickets must be collected in person (or by a nominated representative) from BAFTA in Wales, Chapter, Canton, Cardiff, CF5 1QE on Thursday 26, Friday 27 or the morning of Saturday 28 May, 2011.

Q WHAT IS THE DRESS CODE?

Strictly Black Tie.

Q WILL I BE ABLE TO REQUEST WHO I WOULD LIKE TO BE SEATED WITH?

Seating at Wales Millennium Centre will be allocated accordingly by the BAFTA in Wales office. BAFTA in Wales will do their best to seat guests that have booked together with one another.

Q WILL THERE BE FORMAL SEATING ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE 'SUPPER & PARTY'?

No formal table seating will apply this year for the 'Supper & Party' at the Mercure Cardiff Holland House Hotel & Spa. There will be a wide variety of dishes and drinks available including vegetarian options for all guests. There will be various 'themed' seating areas available at the Hotel.
